


# Tipperary PPN Steps for Electing Reps



## **Step 1: A board/ committee requests representatives from the PPN**

This might be for the board of management of a Community & Voluntary/ Charity organisation or could be to sit on a Council committee or a planning group of some kind. All reps will have different responsibilities which will be defined by the committee/ board requesting them. However the PPN does require the representative to gather the views of a PPN linkage group and feedback to that linkage group so they are representing wider views not just their own organisations. This is explained further below.

## **Step 2: All organisations in the PPN are informed of this opportunity**

Organisations in the PPN are informed via email and the newsletter that a committee/ board is looking for representatives, so it is important to check your PPN email notifications regularly.

## **Step 3: Interested organisations are asked to join a linkage group to this board/ committee**

Your organisation needs to join the linkage group by the publicised deadline in order to nominate a representative to the committee/ board. Membership of the linkage group does not mean your organisation needs to nominate a rep but does mean that you can vote for who you would like the rep to be, so it is important to join these linkage groups to have a say about who is the PPN representative of issues important to your organisation.

## **Step 4: The Committee/ Board's Linkage Group members will be asked to nominate a rep from their organisation to sit on the board/ committee**

There will be strict deadlines to join the linkage group and also to nominate a rep from that linkage group. Organisations who wish to join this linkage group after the deadline has closed must wait until after the election of candidates has taken place.

## **Step 5: Election**

If there are more nominees than seats available an election evening will take place, this date will be highlighted at step 2 so please note all of these important dates/ deadlines in your diary.
